- ✓ Advanced intermediate knowledge of oral French is required



**Regular Skilled Worker
Program (PRTQ)***

- ✓ Unforeseeable delays

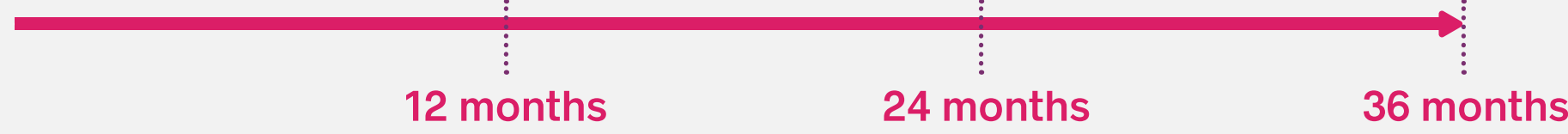

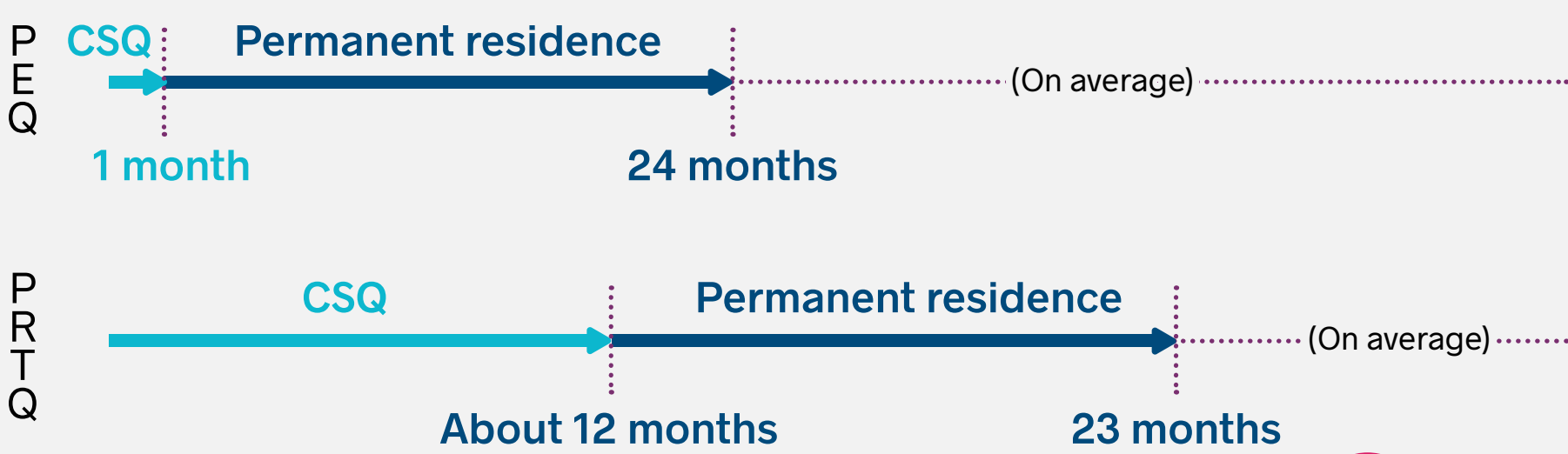
