

Elementary school

CEGEPS provide a stepping stone between secondary school and university. CEGEP is a French acronym that stands for Collège d'enseignement général et professionnel, known in English as a general and vocational college.

CEGEPS provide pre-university programs, leading to university studies, and technical career programs, which prepare students to enter the job market.

It's important to note that international students are not all required to go to CEGEP before applying for admission to a university in Québec.
